FSW Update from Nikki Kerr, FSW Director of Fundraising and Marketing:



"Dear Friends,

We are all finding it hard to believe that we are approaching the end of another year! The last few months really have flown by and now we are already planning all of our Christmas activities and family support.

We are very grateful to everybody who contributed to Harvest Festival collections, which brought our foodbank levels up to a satisfactory level after months of low stock. The food deliveries are so appreciated by our families who are continuing to find basic household essentials hard to afford.

Over the last few weeks since schools returned for the new term we have again been inundated with new referrals. Many more of our families are now coming to us as victims of domestic abuse, which necessitates incredibly sensitive and difficult conversations, so please do keep all of these parents in your thoughts.

September's work in numbers: 204 individual visits and 1071 calls with families supporting 222 adults and 171 children; 47 supported meetings with other agencies; 46 group sessions held supporting 402 parents and 239 children; 85 food deliveries made.


