"Dear Friends,

With so many plans being made for Christmas parties, hampers, pantomime visits and associated activities it is sometimes easy to forget the core work which is so vital for our families. Recently our practitioners have been

supporting many families in incredibly difficult situations including a family of 7 living in 2-bed emergency accommodation, and a single parent family in which the mother has just been diagnosed with a terminal illness. The huge variety of families who are referred to us means a wide range of support needs, and we are fortunate that amongst our practitioner team we have some specialist experience which can be shared (some of our practitioners have particular experience in SEN issues, supporting victims of domestic violence, and supporting first time parents). It makes such a difference to our families."
